

MY BEST SCIENCE EXPERIMENTS FOR KIDS:

HOW TO MAKE SUGAR CRYSTALS

STUFF YOU NEED:

1. ONE CUP WATER (240ml)
2. THREE CUPS ORDINARY HOUSEHOLD SUGAR (600g)*
3. FOOD COLORING
4. MASON JAR AND SMALL SPOON
5. STRING made of cotton or wool (not nylon)

* You can use BROWN SUGAR for variety



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INSTRUCTIONS

- STEP ONE:** PLACE THE WATER AND SUGAR IN A PAN.
- STEP TWO:** STIR WELL AS YOU BRING TO THE BOIL.
- STEP THREE:** WHEN BOILING, ADD FOOD COLOR AND FLAVORING.
- STEP FOUR:** LEAVE TO COOL.
- STEP FIVE:** TIE SOME STRING TO A POPSICLE OR SPOON.
- STEP SIX:** PLACE IN THE MIDDLE OF THE MASON JAR.
- STEP SEVEN:** FILL WITH THE SUGAR SOLUTION.
- STEP FIVE:** COVER WITH PAPER TOWEL TO KEEP THE DUST OUT.
- STEP SIX:** LEAVE FOR ONE WEEK.



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
